



## KALOS GOLF CRUISES

### COAST OF SPAIN & THE FRENCH RIVIERA

In 1931, when financier E. F. Hutton made *Sea Cloud* for his wife, Marjorie Merriweather-Post, he couldn't have dreamed that the 360-foot schooner—once the largest private ship ever built and host to the duke and duchess of Windsor and FDR—would someday serve as a golf cruise ship. In the hands of Kalos Golf, which uses *Sea Cloud* for its movable feast of golf, culinary splendor, and high-seas adventure, the craft is an elegant affair of staterooms with Louis Philippe chairs, teak decks, and 60 crew members. *Sea Cloud* hosts three two-week cruises yearly. Some stops along the Spanish coast are such top layouts as Valderrama, site of the 1997 Ryder Cup; Montecastillo, a Nicklaus design near Cádiz; and San Roque, near Gibraltar. On the Riviera cruise (there are two journeys to the region), there's the Monte-Carlo club, on Monaco's Mount Agel, and Is Molas resort, in Sardinia.
